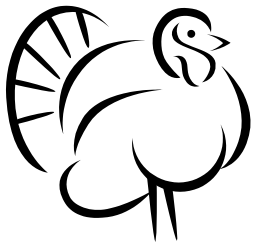

Thanksgiving Service Sunday Nov 20th at 7:00 p.m.

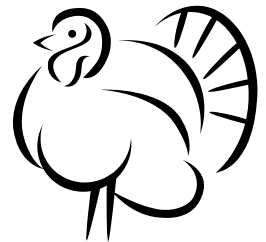
The youth will be participating in the service with skits and scripture reading.
